**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MARSHALLTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE A MILO RANGE PRO FIREARMS TRAINING SIMULATOR SYSTEM UTILIZING FFE BUDGET DOLLARS FROM THE FIRE AND POLICE BUILDING PROJECT AND SURPLUS FUNDS IDENTIFIED IN THE FIRE AND POLICE BUILDING PROJECT BUDGET**

**WHEREAS** the City of Marshalltown (hereinafter referred to as the "City"), State of Iowa, is a political subdivision organized and existing under the laws of the State of Iowa and the Constitution of the State of Iowa (the "State"); and

**WHEREAS** the Marshalltown Police Department requests authorization to purchase a MILO Range Pro Firearms Training Simulator system; and

**WHEREAS** the new police building has a room designed for use as a firearms simulator training area; and

**WHEREAS** the Council has found it to be in the best interests of the City of Marshalltown, Iowa, and the Marshalltown Police Department that said purchase should be made.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City of Marshalltown, Iowa authorizes and directs the Chief of Police to purchase a MILO Range Pro Firearms Training Simulator system.

Section 2. The Chief of Police is authorized to utilize unobligated funds from the fire and police building project FFE budget and designated surplus funds connected with the fire and police building project to accomplish this purchase.
