

RESOLUTION 2019-097 APPROVING ADDENDUM TO RESOLUTION 2019-012
ACCEPTING BID AND AUTHORIZING THE AWARD AND APPROVAL OF
CONTRACT FOR THE CHIPPING OF TORNADO RELATED TREE DEBRIS PROJECT
IN THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA,
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$59,980.00

WHEREAS bids were received for the Tornado Related Tree Debris Project, in the City of Marshalltown; and

WHEREAS, bids and surety bonds were received from the following bidders, to-wit:

After consideration of all bids filed, there was determined by the Council that the bid of Thorp Sawmill & Logging of Jefferson, Iowa, is the best and lowest responsible bid for the project as is herein outlined.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA:

Section 1. That the bid of Thorp Sawmill & Logging, and the same is hereby accepted for the project and that the contract for the construction of same is now awarded and approved to said contractor in the total amount of Fifty-Nine Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty and .00/100 (\$59,980.00) Dollars.

Section 2. The Mayor and Clerk of the City of Marshalltown, Iowa are hereby authorized and directed to execute the contract with the contractor for the project.

Section 3. This resolution as now adopted shall be in full force and binding effect upon the City of Marshalltown, Iowa.

The City will only consider change orders to a contract when the Contractor can show the actual cubic yards exceeds the estimate provided "of 12,274 cubic yards. The City agrees that no hauling or removal of any of the chipped material will be done until measurements have been made and agreed to in writing by the City representative and the Contractor as to the actual cubic yards that have been chipped". The City agrees to pay a lump sum of \$59,980.00 to the Contractor "for the estimated chipping of 12,274 cubic yards".
