Re: Street Improvement Project – E Boone St Intersection Improvements (SMW 21-002)

Policy Issue: City purchasing policy requires the City to utilize competitive bidding procedures for horizontal infrastructure projects estimated to cost more than \$139,000. A Public Hearing is required as part of that procedure. Following the Public Hearing, City Council should approve plans, specifications, form of contract, and cost for said improvements.

Recommendation: Staff recommends approving plans, specifications, form of contract, and cost for said improvements.

Background: Existing storm inlets and piping at the intersections of E Boone St and 15th Ave & E Boone St and 16th Ave have deteriorated. The existing system has high maintenance issues due to not having a gravity flow outlet. In order to address deteriorated infrastructure below the street and improve maintenance in the future, we proposed to regrade the intersections and provide drainage through valley gutters (overland flow).

Design engineering for this project was performed in-house. Construction is estimated to cost \$184,160.

We have a scheduled bid opening at 10:00 AM on March 8th, 2022 and will bring bids back to council on March 14th, 2022 for consideration.

Budget Impact: This project will be funded through the City's Street Improvement Program with funds coming from budgeted FY22 & FY23. Revenue sources for the City's Street Improvement Program have been allocated through Fund 110 (Road Use Tax), Fund 360 (2019 GO Bond), and Fund 363 (2021 GO Bond).
