

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE MARSHALL COUNTY/MUNICIPAL
MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT**

WHEREAS, the City of Marshalltown (hereinafter referred to as the “City”), State of Iowa, is a political subdivision organized and existing under the law and the Constitution of the State of Iowa (the “State”); and

WHEREAS, Section 28E.31 of the Chapters 28 E Code of Iowa permit public agencies to enter into an agreement to share specific services in a mutually agreeable manner; and

WHEREAS, any public agency required to provide fire protection under Section 364.16, Code of Iowa, unless already contracting fire protection with another municipality, shall pass a resolution to enter into this agreement as a part of the Marshall County Mutual Aid agreement; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this agreement is to permit and provide for assistance on a reciprocal basis (mutual aid), among the fire department agencies of the participating jurisdictions, in the event of an emergency incident only when the normal resources available to the requesting jurisdiction are inadequate to meet the emergency incident demands; and

WHEREAS, this agreement is in the best interest of the City of Marshalltown.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the City approves the Marshall County Mutual Aid Agreement; and the Mayor, is hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement on behalf of the City.
