

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING INTERNAL DEBT REIMBURSEMENT TO TAX INCREMENT REVENUE FUND, FOR URBAN RENEWAL AREA NO. 7

WHEREAS, the City of Marshalltown, Iowa (the “City”), has established the Highway 14 Corridor TIF, Urban Renewal Area No. 7 (the “Urban Renewal Area”) and has created the Highway 14 Corridor TIF, Urban Renewal Area No. 7 Tax Increment Revenue Fund (the “Tax Increment Fund”) in connection therewith; and

WHEREAS, the City has undertaken an urban renewal projects consistence with the Plan for and in the Urban Renewal Area (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, in order to cover the costs of the Project and to make such costs eligible to be reimbursed from future incremental property tax revenues, it is necessary to make an internal loan transfer;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The following costs have been incurred or may be incurred and are eligible to be repaid out of future incremental property tax revenues received with respect to the Urban Renewal Area, for the following expenses:
