

RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AND AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR THE HUD LEAD-BASED PAINT HAZARD REDUCTION PROGRAM GRANT FROM THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT

WHEREAS the City of Marshalltown (hereinafter referred to as the “City”), State of Iowa, is a political subdivision organized and existing under the law and the Constitution of the State of Iowa (the “State”); and

WHEREAS the City of Marshalltown has been making homes lead safe for 20 years in Marshalltown; and

WHEREAS the City of Marshalltown recognizes the need to eliminate lead poisoning and continues to support the goals established by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), on the elimination of these poisonings; and

WHEREAS the City is prepared to meet the 10% minimum match requirement of grant funding using a combination of in-kind contributions, property owner contributions and cash contributions if needed through City funds to meet the minimum requirement; and

WHEREAS the City Council finds this application to be within the best interest of the City and if awarded the City will administer the program and will enter into detailed agreements regarding the administration of the program with participating entities.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the staff of the City Housing and Community Development Department is directed to apply for HUD funding under the Lead Hazard Reduction Grant Program FR-6600-N-13 to provide for education, outreach, identification, removal and remediation of lead-based paint hazards and for other items related to the lead hazard reduction and healthy homes repairs in an amount not to exceed the maximum allowable grant award set by HUD of \$5,000,000 dollars for lead hazard reduction and \$700,000 for healthy homes interventions.

Section 2. The City council agrees to provide the necessary matching contribution to meet the required minimum 10% amount.

Section 3. If awarded that the Mayor and City staff are authorized to negotiate the terms of the award and execute any required contracts and documents associated with the acceptance of the award.
