

**RESOLUTION APPROVING USE OF COUNCIL-DESIGNATED LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX NOT-TO-EXCEED \$12,000 FOR ATTENDANCE AT THE 2023 CO-RESPONDER CONFERENCE**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved an agreement with Youth and Shelter Services of Marshall County (“YSS”) on December 27, 2021, with Resolution 2021-366; and

**WHEREAS**, the contract was amended in 2022 to allow for attendance at the conference to be considered an eligible expense for reimbursement to all YSS and the Marshalltown Police Department staff to attend the 2022 Co-Responder Conference; and

**WHEREAS**, the intent in 2022 was to utilize remaining General Fund dollars that were no longer obligated as of June 30, 2022 to pay for both Police Department and Youth and Shelter Service staff to attend the conference, which did not happen as the conference registration was full; and

**WHEREAS**, Police Department and Youth and Shelter Services personnel would like to attend the 2023 Co-Responder Conference in Spokane, Washington, June 12-14;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA**, an amount not-to-exceed \$12,000 of Council-designated Local Option Sales Tax is hereby dedicated to allow for Police Department and Youth and Shelter Services staff to attend the 2023 Co-Responder Conference.
