

ORDINANCE VACATING ALLEY

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE THE EAST AND WEST ALLEY BETWEEN SOUTH TWELFTH STREET AND SOUTH THIRTEENTH STREET IN THE FIRST BLOCK SOUTH OF WEST MAIN STREET

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, IOWA.

Section 1. That the east and west alley between South Twelfth Street and South Thirteenth Street in the first block South of West Main Street and lying between Lot 38 of Messenger's Sub-Division of Lot One (1) and Lots One (1) of Two (2), Two (2) of Two (2), Three (3) of Two (2) and Four (4) of Two (2) all in the Sub-Division of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34-84-18 on the North side thereof and Lot 37 of Messengers Sub-Division of Lot One (1) and Lots Seven (7) of Two (2), Eight (8) of Two (2) Nine (9) of Two (2) Ten (10) of Two (2) and Eleven (11) of Two (2) all in the Sub-Division of the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34-84-18 on the South side thereof, be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
