

RESOLUTION TO SET PARAMETERS FOR THE USE OF AUTOMATED TRAFFIC ENFORCMENT (ATE) FUNDS FOR QUALITY OF LIFE PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the use of automated traffic enforcement devices in the City of Marshalltown began in 2023 and the revenues have not yet been designated; and

WHEREAS, the Marshalltown City Council wishes to designate the automated traffic enforcement funds for the purpose of community safety and beautification in an effort to improve the quality of life in Marshalltown.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARSHALLTOWN, authorizes the use of automated traffic enforcement revenues, for revenues collected after October 1, 2023 as follows.

Section 1.

- a. Up to 25% of funds received annually, not to exceed \$125,000, shall be used for Police Department technology and crime prevention initiatives.
- b. Up to 25% of funds received annually, not to exceed \$125,000, shall be used for the implementation of the Arts and Culture Master Plan.
- c. Up to 50% of funds received annually, not to exceed \$250,000, shall be used for community beautification projects such as park improvements, maintenance of City entrance points/thoroughfares, and nuisance enforcement.

Section 2. In order for the funds to be released, specific requests that meet the defined criteria must be approved by Council resolution.

Section 3. If additional funds are available, the Council may exceed the defined percentages and not exceed amounts for projects that provide additional community benefit. Such action shall be approved by Council resolution.

Section 4. If at any time ATE revenues are not available, any previous Council approved uses will not be funded.
