## **Summer Blast Day Camp**

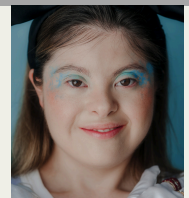

## **Camp Marshalltown Day Camp**

**Family:** Up to two adults residing at the same address and legally supported children age 18 and under. Exceptions: 1. Children up to age 21 who are post-secondary students 2. Adult dependents claimed as taxable dependent. Documentation may be required to determine family status. Fraudulent information will result in pass revocation and no refund.

**Nanny:** A person age 15 or older, who actively supervises one or more children in the water. Nanny must be included at the time the season pass is purchased. Only one nanny may be added per season pass and waiver must be signed before sale.

## Water Walking & Lap Swim

June 7 - August 24

Hours: Mon - Sun 11:30 AM - 12:30 PM  
Mon - Fri 7:30 - 8:30 PM

- Steps and ramp allow easy access in and out of the lazy river, which is 556 linear feet in length.
- Children age 10-13 may participate WITH an adult participating in the same activity (both adult and child must water walk or lap swim). No children allowed to stay on deck while parents participate.
- All who enter the facility during this time must either water walk or lap swim.
- Participants who wish to swim must do so in the designated lap lanes area.
- Participants in the lazy river must walk or jog. No swimming is allowed in the lazy river.
- Slower walkers must stay to the right so faster water walkers may pass safely.
- Sessions will be cancelled if there is severe weather. Light rain will not cancel a session.
- \*The Marshalltown Family Aquatic Center reserves the right to change any of these policies at any time, should the need arise.

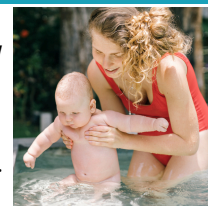

## Adult Tot Swim

June 7 - August 23

Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays 11:30 AM - 12:30 PM

Adults and children, age 6 and younger, are invited to enjoy the zero depth and shallow areas of the Aquatic Center, at this time, while the water features are off. Adults must actively supervise their children in the water at all times. Admission includes up to 2 children free with each paid adult. Season passes and 15-pass scan cards are accepted.



## Birthday Splash

Age 12 or younger

Reserve a table at the Aquatic Center, during open swim hours, for your child's birthday party. Price includes admission for 10 people (which includes all age swimmers and non-swimmers) to swim all day, and the birthday table area use for 2 hours. Children under age 3 are admitted free. Cake and table service may be brought in for your party. Hold your party from 1-3 or 4-6 PM. No other food or beverages are permitted.



# Swimming Lessons

We offer indoor and outdoor swimming lessons. During cold months, the indoor lessons will be offered at Central AEA Pleasant Hill Pool at 909 S 12th Street. Otherwise, lessons are held at the Aquatic Center.

Learn to swim classes are \$45 for 45 mins (8 total classes)  
Preschool lessons are \$40 for 30 mins (8 total classes)

Refunds requested, before the enrollment deadline, will be given. No refunds will be given after the enrollment deadline.

\*Marshalltown Youth Foundation offers financial assistance for qualified Marshalltown youth



Red Cross guidelines are followed. Class sizes are limited and may be combined or canceled due to low enrollment. Children may be moved to different classes based on skill level.

- Swimmers and parents will enter and exit the facility through the main entrance of the aquatic center and be seated in the concession area.
- Swimmers shall not attend if they have a fever (100.4 or higher or diarrhea, vomiting, or upper respiratory infection/congestion).
- Swimmers will be escorted by their instructor to and from the lesson area.
- Parents and caregivers must stay in the concession area.
- Swimmers should come swim-ready and bring a towel.
- Questions during lessons can be directed to the Swim Lesson Coordinator.

All sessions meet Monday - Thursday and Fridays are make-up days.

# What will I learn?

## **Intro to Water (Ages 0-2, with a parent)**

Lessons, for ages 0-2, is to teach safe behaviors around the water and develop swimming readiness by leading parents and their children in water exploration activities with the objective of having fun and becoming comfortable in, on, and around water.

## **Preschool Lessons (Ages 3-5)**

May be performed with assistance  
Exit water using ladder, steps or side  
Enter water by stepping in from deck or low height  
Jump in to shoulder-deep water  
Blow bubbles  
Fully submerge and hold breath  
Bobbing 5-10 times  
Open eyes under water and retrieve objects

Front and back glide and recover  
Back float for 3-15 secs  
Front, jellyfish, and tuck floats  
Roll from front-to-back and back-to-front  
Tread water using arm & leg actions for 15-30 secs  
Combined arm and leg actions on front and back  
Finning arm action on back

## **Learn to Swim Level 1 (Age 5+)**

Enter and exit water using ramps, steps, or side  
Exit water using ladder, steps, or side  
Blow bubbles for 3 seconds  
Bobbing 5 times  
Open eyes under water and retrieve objects  
Front and back glide and recover  
Back float for 5 secs  
Roll from front-back and back-front  
Treading water arm and hand action  
Alternating leg and arm actions on front and back  
Combined arm and leg actions on front and back

## **Learn to Swim Level 2**

Step or jump from side into shoulder-deep water  
Exit water using ladder, steps, or side  
Fully submerge and hold breath  
Bobbing 10 times  
Open eyes under water and retrieve submerged objects  
Rotary breathing  
Front, jellyfish, tuck floats 10 seconds  
Front & back glide and recover  
Back float for 15 seconds  
Roll from front-to-back and back-to-front  
Tread water for 15 seconds  
Change direction while swimming front or back  
Combined arm and leg actions on front and back

## **Learn to Swim Level 3**

Jump into deep water from side, submerge and return to side  
Headfirst entry from side in seated or kneeling position  
Bobbing while moving to safety  
Rotary breathing  
Survival float for 30 seconds  
Back float for 1 minute  
Tread water for 1 minute  
Change from vertical to horizontal position/front and back  
Push off in streamlined position on front then begin kicking  
Swim the front crawl for 15 yards  
Swim the elementary backstroke for 15 yards

## **Learn to Swim Level 4 (Outdoor only)**

Headfirst entry in compact and stride positions  
Feetfirst surface dive  
Swim underwater  
Tread water, using 2 different kicks  
Survival swim for 1 minute  
Front crawl - 25 yards  
Elementary backstroke - 25 yards  
Breaststroke - 15 yards  
Back crawl - 15 yards  
Butterfly- 15 yards  
Open turns on the front and back  
Flutter and dolphin kicks on back  
Push off in streamlined position on back and begin kicking

## **Urban Bow Hunting**

Date: September 2025-Jan 2025 Location: Zone 78 Cost: \$40/session

The Urban Deer Bow Hunting Program is a cooperative effort between the City of Marshalltown and the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR). The purpose of the program is deer management within the city limits. The IDNR controls the number of deer hunting licenses issued for hunting within the city limits. An urban bow hunting license is for hunting of antlerless deer only during this annually specified season. To receive an urban bow hunting permit, hunters must meet all the requirements established by the IDNR for bow hunting and City regulations, when more restrictive than State regulations. Please see our website for more information.

The City issues a permit necessary to then obtain urban deer hunting licenses. With a \$10 fee, a permit may be issued at the Parks and Recreation Department, 10 West State, 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. The IDNR special urban license, for Zone 78, may be purchased in Marshalltown from Theisen's.



**Patrons may come to the Parks and Recreation office, located at 10 W State Street, between 8:30 AM- 4:30 PM to check out volleyballs and nets, soccer balls, and footballs - free of charge. Ice skates are a nominal charge of \$2/day.**

This four-acre area, along the east end of Riverview park, is a space that is loved by large and small dogs alike! There are separate fenced areas for large and small dogs to run unleashed.

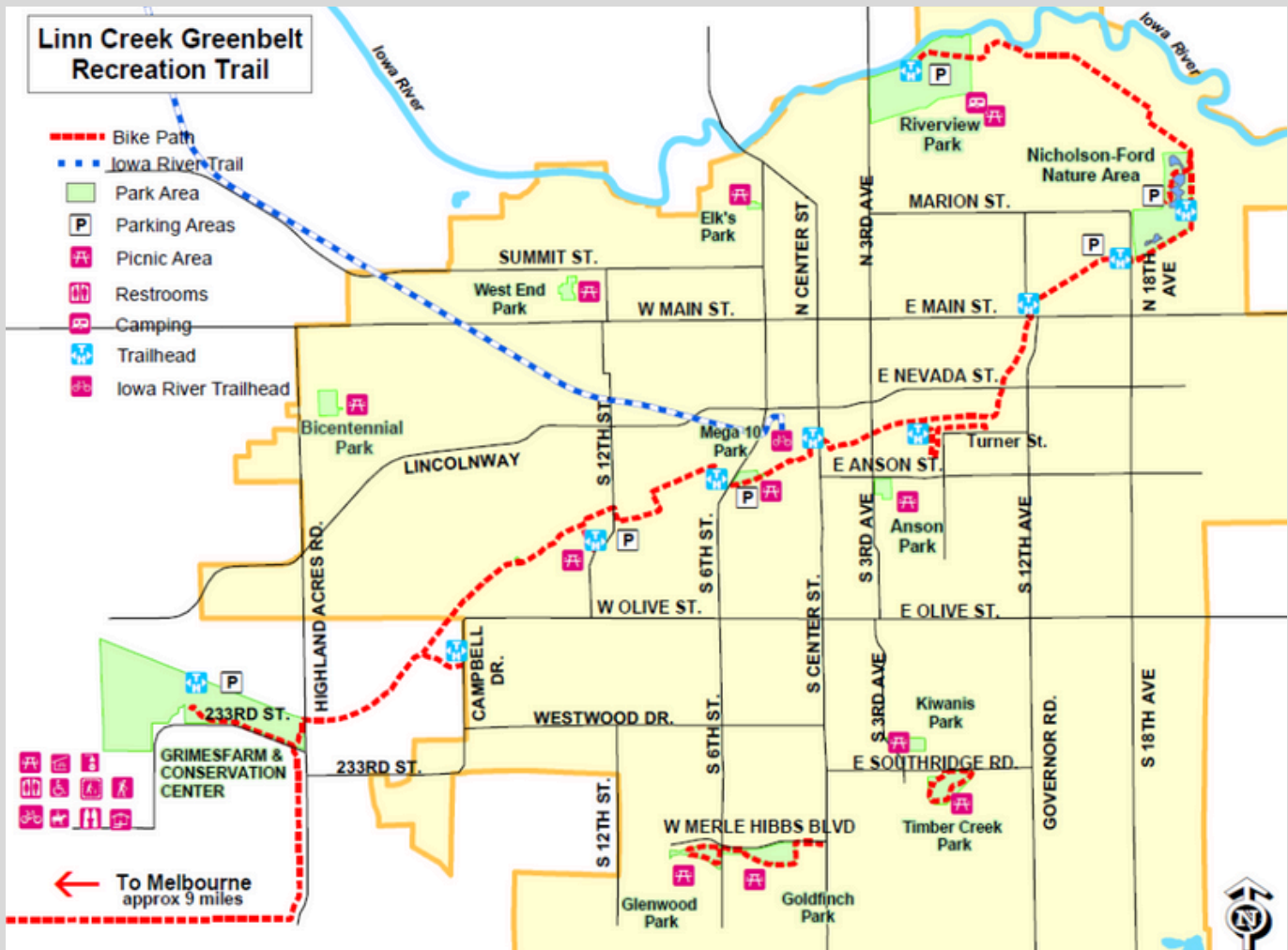
Daily use fee is \$3 per dog. Fee is to be placed in envelopes provided and left in the drop box. Annual [Dog Park Membership Registration](#) forms are available online, from local veterinary clinics and at the Parks & Recreation office.

Annual registration asks the expiration dates of Parvo/Distemper and Rabies, if your dog is spayed or neutered and veterinary clinic contact information. Annual membership fee is \$30, with a \$5 discount when your dog is spayed or neutered. Annual membership is January 1 - December 31.





# Linn Creek Recreational Trail



The Linn Creek Recreational Trail is a 15 mile hard-surfaced trail and was resurfaced in 2021. This trail follows Linn Creek and the Iowa River in Marshalltown and extends from Riverview Park to the west to Grimes Farm Conservation Center. On Highland Acres Road, a connecting trail may be followed Southwest into the town of Melbourne.

The trail has several short loops linking a variety of outdoor opportunities, including the campground, restrooms, rental buildings, play areas and: the Dog Park; Nicholson-Ford OHV Park; MEGA 10 Park with its' children discovery garden; Aquatic Center; Skatepark; Sixth Street Softball complex and little league baseball diamonds; along with various playground and picnic areas along the way.





# RIVERVIEW CAMPGROUND

The Riverview Park Campground is located on the north edge of Marshalltown along Highway 14, adjacent to the Iowa River, within Riverview Park at 402 Woodland Street. The campground accommodates large RVs, with drive-through sites. Ten full hookup sites (including water, sewer and 50-amp electricity); 30 electrical hookup sites (50 amp, 30 amp, 20 amp); 17 camper parking pads. **Reservations are not available. All sites are first come, first serve.**

Riverview Park features three enclosed rentable buildings; three open-air shelters; playground areas; tennis courts; basketball court; 18-hole disc golf course; a dog park; three tree sculptures and beautiful flower gardens.



City ordinance limits campground stay to seven nights and an extension of seven additional nights may be granted, up to 14 consecutive nights. After a maximum of 14 consecutive nights of stay, campers must exit the campground for a minimum of twenty-four hours before ability to return.

Cost:

- Full hookups sites - \$30 per night (10 sites: 21A, 21B, 25A, 25B, 26A, 26B, 27A, 27B, 31A, 31B)
- Electric sites - 30 & 50 amp - \$25 per night (60 sites)
- Non-Electric / Tent sites - \$20 per night
- Wood bundle - \$5 each

- Sites are available on a first-come first-serve basis - no reservations are available.
- A self-registration kiosk is located at the entrance with envelopes and deposit box.
- Within an hour of arrival, all campers are asked to complete a registration envelope and pay fee.
- Visibly post the receipt of payment on camping unit, tent or vehicle.
- See campground host for site availability, firewood, shower house, and restroom codes or other assistance.
- Campground checkout time is 4:00 p.m. to avoid an additional night fee
- A dump station is located at the East end of Woodland Street at no charge.

# TREE PROGRAMS

## Tree & Bench Memorials

The City of Marshalltown welcomes donations through our [Memorial Trees and Park Benches](#). These generous donations will grace our public spaces for decades while providing a unique opportunity to honor a special person or to mark a notable event. The physical planting of trees or placement of benches is done by parks staff and the City will assume continued maintenance.

## Rights-of-way Trees

The right-of-way area is the city-owned easement area between the property line and the edge of any street, road or boulevard, including the sidewalk, if present. Parks and Recreation Department staff evaluates the health and safety of trees in these right-of-way areas.

A [Tree Planting Permit](#) is required prior to any planting in a right-of-way area. The location, tree species, area utilities and growth ratio to space will be assessed before approval is granted for planting.

## Trees Forever

Trees Forever is an all-volunteer group dedicated to the planting of a diversity of trees within the city of Marshalltown, encouraging proper tree care and maintenance, and providing educational opportunities to adults and youths. We believe an abundance and diversity of trees in our city improves the quality of life and creates a positive public image.
