\*\*\*\*\* NOTES / CLARIFICATIONS \*\*\*\*\*

1. In cases where the trailer, truck, etc is clearly less than 50% capacity / utilization, the compost attendant has discretion to reduce gate fee / sale price to a lesser category.
2. Where a customer is utilizing bags / containers and have them in a car, van, suv, truck, trailer, etc – the compost attendant can calculate gate fees / sale price both ways (categories) and charge the lesser.
3. Please sort loads into three categories (1) leaves, vegetation, and grasses, (2) sticks and small branches, and (3) larger limbs and tree trunks.
